Overriding Principles

The following principles lay out the rules for establishing the priority registration windows listed in the following section.

- Students with documented disabilities and their note takers may register first regardless of classification.
- · Priority Registration Groups:
 - Approved groups are Honors, Athletes, and Forensics.
 - Faculty or staff members who wish to add additional groups must contact the deans' office.
 - Priority registration Senior status is defined as students who have earned 75 or more credits.
 - All other priority registration students will be defined as 0-74 earned credits
- Non-priority registration students will be defined using the following earned credits classifications:
 - 90+ Seniors
 - · 60-89 Juniors
 - · 30-59 Second Year
 - 0-29 First Year

Registration Windows

Registration windows will open in the following priority order:

Group 1 (Seniors)

- Students with documented disabilities, note takers, and priority registration Senior status students
- · Seniors
- · All graduate students

Group 2 (Juniors)

- · All other priority registration students
- Juniors
- · Success students in second year (30-59 earned credits)

Group 3 (Second Years)

- Second years
- · AOS First year students
- · Success students in first year (0-29 earned credits)

Group 4 (First Years)

· First years
